My fellow Kiwanians: I want to wish you a Happy New Year and hope that this year will be prosperous for you and your family. This is also a special year for Kiwanis as it marks our 100th birthday. I am HAPPY to be a part of such an organization....Are you?

The original

Kiwanis Club—Detroit Kiwanis Club No. 1—set the example of Kiwanis service with one of the first projects devoted to children. Walter was a 5-year-old boy from a broken home in a poverty-stricken area of Detroit. The father, an alcoholic, could not provide properly for his family. Walter's mother divorced him and was in deep financial trouble when the club became aware of her plight. With the mother's permission, the Kiwanis club found a foster home for the boy with an elderly couple. Kiwanis took care of all his needs, legally adopting him and giving him Kiwanis as his last name. "It was the best thing that ever happened to the club," said the club's Charter President Don Johnston. "Every member was soon rushing around to see who would have the opportunity to buy the lad a new overcoat, a new suit, or a toy. Little Walter became an institution—the basis for the humanitarian ideals that made the Detroit club famous." Some years later, Walter's mother remarried, and she and her new husband resumed custody of "Walter Kiwanis."

District Education Module "The Convention Delegate"

Duties of the Club President:

- ☐ Encourage financial support in the club's budget to assist voting delegates with convention registration costs and travel expenses
- ☐ In accordance with club by-laws, ensure that voting delegates are elected in a timely manner relative to the date of the convention and that notice of the delegate election is sent to the appropriate Kiwanis International or District Office contact depending on the convention
- □ Prior to the convention, provide ample time at a club meeting for the presentation of by-law amendments and resolutions that will come before the House of Delegates
- □ Determine a streamlined approach for delegates to receive input from the membership regarding their opinion on issues that will be voted on at the convention
- ☐ Prior to the convention, circulate materials received regarding candidates seeking election for higher office
- ☐ After the convention, provide ample time at a club meeting for a full convention report by the delegates
- ☐ After the convention, arrange for the delegates to be the program speakers at a regularly scheduled meeting of the club, to make an education presentation regarding the forums attended at the convention.
